

Excess Gas Service Length Acknowledgement Letter

Effective date of Jan 1, 2012

Union Gas will install at no charge to the customer/homeowner, a residential natural gas service up to 30 metres in length under normal construction conditions, with the attachment of one "load bearing" application*. The distance will be measured from property line adjacent to the gas meter location (the preferred location for the gas meter is 2 metres from the front corner of the house). Excess length will be charged at a rate of \$45 + tax per metre of service line and applied to the customers/homeowners or occupant's Union Gas bill.

Additional costs will apply when;

- Extreme construction conditions are identified (for example; full bedrock for the length of the service)
- A customer requests pressure gas (that is above the standard 7" w.c. or 1.75kPa delivery pressure), and a Registered Pressure Factor Metering station is required. A one-time charge of \$1,635.00 will apply.
- A new service is requested for a lot previously serviced by Union Gas

Union Gas will contact the applicant to advise of any additional charges, and will request an additional signed agreement, prior to construction.

Union Gas requires this Acknowledgement letter be signed and submitted before your service request will be processed.

*A load bearing application is defined as a central heat source (ie. furnace) or water heater
